



Upgrading the Pacific Highway **Oxley Highway to Kempsey**

Sancrox Road to Blackmans Point Road community meeting

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority is continuing with the development of the Pacific Highway upgrade between the Oxley Highway and Kempsey. Details of the preferred route were on display until Friday 13 October 2006.

A meeting is being held to provide an update on the proposed location of interchanges and service roads and also to identify issues from Sancrox Road to Blackmans Point Road.

The meeting follows consultation with Port Macquarie Hastings Council and consideration of feedback in community submissions regarding interchange arrangements.

Following discussions with the existing community liaison group, the group will continue to act as a two-way communication link between the project team, the community and stakeholders during the next stages of the project.
