COMMUNITY MEETING FOR WOOLGOOLGA TO WELLS CROSSING PACIFIC HIGHWAY UPGRADE

Members of the community are being asked to comment on access arrangements for the Pacific Highway upgrade between Woolgoolga and Wells Crossing.

An RTA spokesperson said feedback from the community meeting will assist in the development of the concept design and environmental assessment.

“The RTA encourages community members to attend the information session on **Wednesday 28 February at Yarrowarra**,” the spokesperson said.

“A meeting is being held to provide an update on access arrangements in the area.

“The meeting will provide community members with the opportunity to discuss the proposals with the project team.

“The design of the preferred route for the Woolgoolga to Wells Crossing upgrade will be refined once feedback from the community is received as well as the results from further survey, geotechnical and ecological investigations.”

“The information session will take place at the Yarrowarra Conference Centre, 170 Red Rock Road, Corindi Beach from 6pm to 8pm.
