

# Upgrading the Pacific Highway

## Woolgoolga to Wells Crossing



### Project update - May 2007

The NSW Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is continuing with investigations to upgrade the Pacific Highway to dual carriageway from Woolgoolga to Wells Crossing.

The preferred route was on display for community comment until Friday 13 October 2006.

### Preferred route Barcoongere Way and Luthers Road

The preferred routes in the Barcoongere Way and Luthers Road areas were subject to further environmental, agricultural, property and community consultations. The preferred route for Barcoongere Way is shown below.

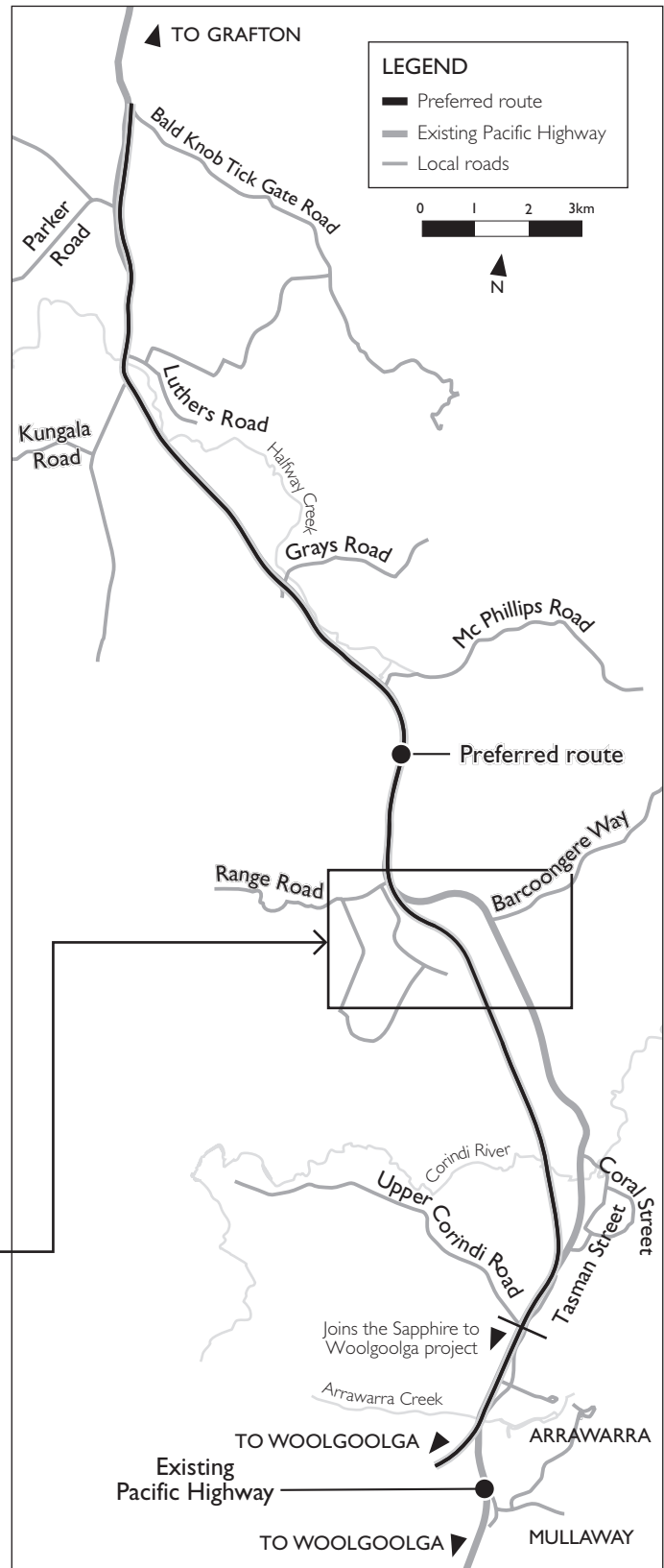
In the Luthers Road area, the preferred route is along and adjacent to the existing highway alignment.

### What happens next?

The design for the preferred route will be refined and approval of the proposal will be requested under Part 3A of the NSW *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979*. The RTA will examine the potential impacts of the preferred route. The refined design and environmental assessment will be displayed for community comment prior to an assessment of the proposal by the NSW Department of Planning and consideration for approval by the NSW Minister for Planning.
