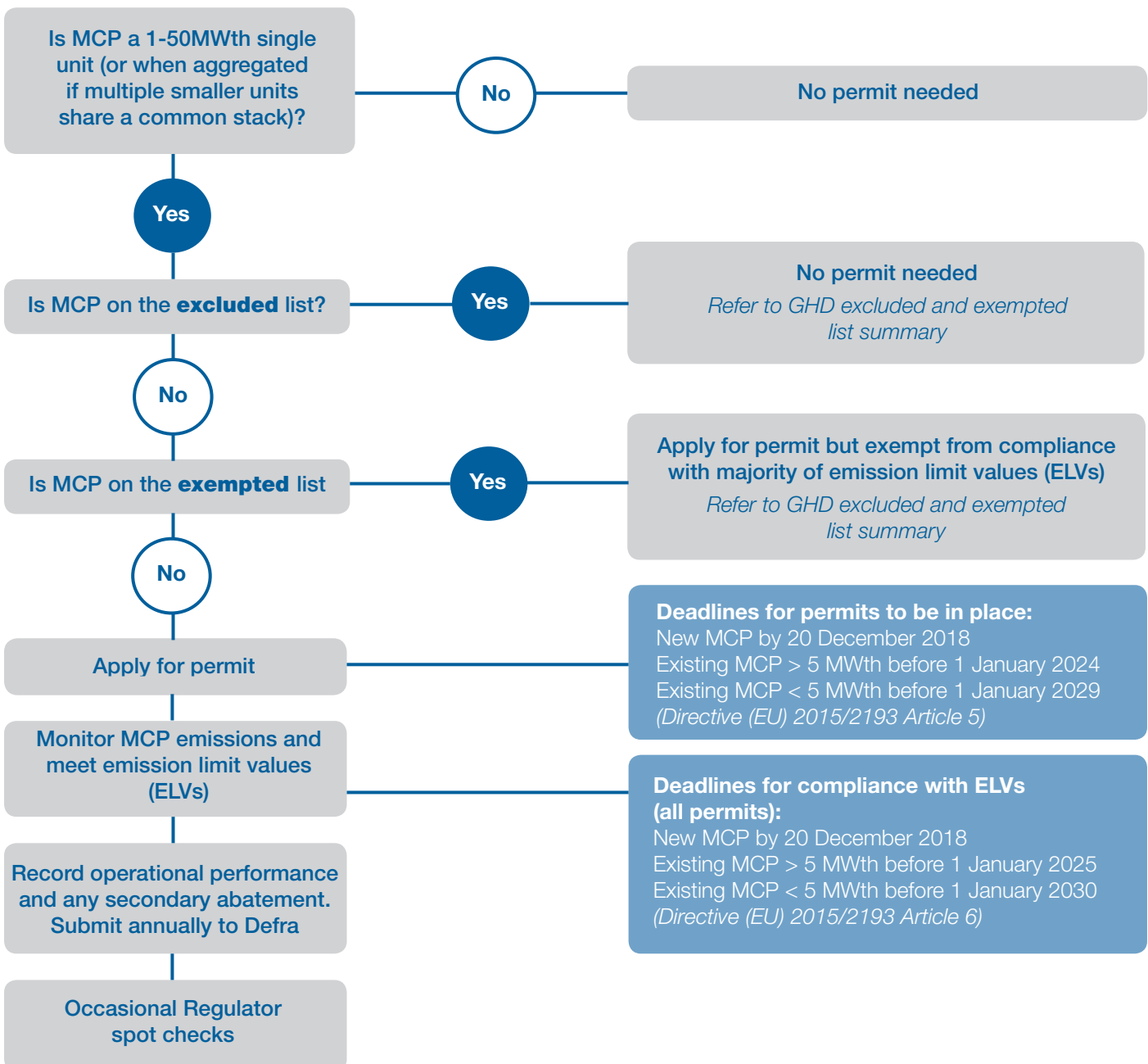
Applies to medium combustion plant (MCP) in the range 1-50MWth (megawatts thermal input)

MCP can be a boiler, heater, generator or engine

A permit is required by law in England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland - if not already permitted*
